#### The Issue

Root cause: A root cause for homelessness in families is that, some families have a barrier that prevents them from accessing resources, such as not having state issued ID's.

1. 84% of homeless families are single mothers with two children which makes it more difficult to find jobs.

According to the Hidden Homeless Report, Tarrant County had 113,084 children living in poverty in 2014. This number represents 22.1 percent of children in the county, higher than the national average.

Nila: "7% of homeless people are in between the age of 18 and younger."

Atali: "Some homeless individuals are uninformed/unaware about the resources available to them."

Andrew: "The main reason for homeless people under 18 is family conflict."

Josh: "I learned that homeless individuals do not often have enough resources to provide for their families."

Camila: "Housing prices have made it more difficult for families to find stable housing."

Colin: "Some homeless individuals don't have ID's, making it harder for them to get a job."
