 - \circ Are able to show the parents, or at least the mother.
 - Breeders require a form saying that you will spay/neuter them.
- Reasons why breeders result to cruel animal breeding practices:
 - Easy profit and cost efficiency
 - Low amounts and quality of food and water
 - No medication
 - Little to no labor, no workers required
 - No enforcement of laws against cruel breeding





Take Action

Actions you can do to help stop cruel animal breeding:

- Look into the breeders you're buying from
- Prioritize adopting from animal shelters over breeders
- Volunteer to foster and or help out at animal shelters
- Report any knowledge of animal cruelty to authorities
- Help spread awareness about cruel animal breeding
- Look into animal welfare organizations and or donate money to help the animals
